**S.B. 604—Creating a Task Force on
Internet-Based Instruction**

For Your Information

Dear Superintendent:

Senate Bill 604 becomes effective July 1, 2009. This new bill creates the Task Force on Internet-Based Instruction.

The purpose of the Task Force shall be to conduct a comprehensive review of Internet-based instruction in the state of Oklahoma and make recommendations regarding necessary changes to ensure accountability for such programs in public schools.

The task force shall submit a report by November 30, 2009, to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives. The report shall include findings and recommendations for any statutory or regulatory changes necessary to improve the accountability, funding, and effectiveness of Internet-based instruction.
