

Oklahoma Criminal Code: Section 571 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

- a. assault, battery, or assault and battery with a dangerous weapon;
- b. aggravated assault and battery on a police officer, sheriff, highway patrolman, or any other officer of the law;
- c. poisoning with intent to kill;
- d. shooting with intent to kill;
- e. assault with intent to commit a felony;
- f. assaults while masked or disguised;
- g. murder in the first degree;
- h. murder in the second degree;
- i. manslaughter in the first degree;
- j. manslaughter in the second degree;
- k. kidnapping;
- l. burglary in the first degree;
- m. burglary with explosives;
- n. kidnapping for extortion;
- o. maiming;
- p. robbery;
- q. robbery in the first degree;
- r. robbery in the second degree;
- s. armed robbery;
- t. robbery by two (2) or more persons;
- u. robbery with dangerous weapon or imitation firearm;
- v. child beating;
- w. wiring any equipment, vehicle or structure with explosives;
- x. forcible sodomy;
- y. rape in the first degree;
- z. rape in the second degree;
- aa. rape by instrumentation;
- bb. lewd or indecent proposition or lewd or indecent act with a child;
- cc. use of a firearm or offensive weapon to commit or attempt to commit a felony;
- dd. pointing firearms;
- ee. rioting;
- ff. inciting to riot;
- gg. arson in the first degree;
- hh. injuring or burning public buildings;
- ii. sabotage;
- jj. criminal syndicalism;
- kk. extortion;
- ll. obtaining signature by extortion;
- mm. seizure of a bus
- nn. discharging firearm or hurling missile at bus; or
- oo. mistreatment of a mental patient.
